



## Training in Fire Safety Design and Management in Healthcare Premises

### An opportunity for those working in the Healthcare Fire Safety Environment

Following the success of the last 3 years seeing 6 fully subscribed courses University Hospitals Plymouth NHS Trust will be hosting a further 2 courses in 2019 for Fire Safety in the Design and Management in Healthcare Premises

Delegates are invited from other trusts, Emergency Services or others involved in Healthcare Premises Fire Safety.

#### Course Overview

The course is designed to develop existing fire safety practitioners or those working within the healthcare field, in the understanding of the relevant Firecode suite of documents (Health Technical Memorandum). The HTM documents are the bench mark standard for the design, management and fire risk assessment in healthcare premises and provide best practice standards and policy to enable the successful management of fire safety.

Course Duration : 5 days

#### Learning Outcomes

On successful completion of the course, delegates will be able to interpret and use the HTM suite of documents as they relate to fire safety design and management within healthcare premises.

The subjects covered are:

- HTM 05-01: Managing healthcare fire safety
- HTM 05-02: Guidance in support of functional provisions for healthcare premises.
- HTM 05-03: Operational provisions manuals
  - Part A General Fire Safety
  - Part B Fire Detection and Alarm Systems
  - Part D Commercial Enterprises on Healthcare Premises
  - Part E Escape lifts in Healthcare Premises
  - Part M Guidance on the Fire Safety of Atria in Healthcare Premises

Instructional methods will include:

- PowerPoint presentations
- Interactive discussions
- Whiteboard
- Syndicate exercises
- Assessment.

## Who should attend?

This course is designed for healthcare fire safety managers, healthcare fire safety advisers, fire prevention and protection officers from fire & rescue services and other staff who require training in healthcare fire safety.

It is suitable for all those involved in providing advice on the methods for achieving fire prevention and protection appropriate to the assessed fire risk within existing, proposed or altered healthcare premises.

### **Course Entry Criteria:**

Delegates should be involved, about to be involved within a fire safety role in healthcare premises or work within a local authority fire & rescue service.

They should, as a minimum possess an understanding of fire safety principles. Ideally delegates will be existing fire safety practitioners who also have an understanding of current Building Regulations.

The approach will focus on ensuring delegates can apply the relevant knowledge within their workplace.

## Assessment and Accreditation

This course is assessed against the learning outcomes by a plan based exercise and a supplementary written question paper. A certificate will be awarded upon successful completion of the course.
